Approximately 4000 attended this year's MN Muskie Expo held March 9, 10 & 11 at the National Sports Center in Blaine, making this one of the most successful Expos ever for promoter George Wahl. Because of an agreement made between George and our chapter for the first Expo, a portion of the proceeds comes back to our chapter. This year, George presented a check for \$2,800 to the chapter, making a total of over \$60,000 coming back to the chapter because of the Expo. Thank you, George and thank you to all the chapter members who supported the Expo this year.

## Rearing Fund Raffle Officially Kicks Off!

The 2007 Rearing Raffle officially kicked off at the Muskie Expo March 9th through 11. We got off to a great start selling \$1455 worth of raffle tickets in three days. Friday was our best single-event day ever, with \$608 sold. A big thanks to George Wahl who again provided our club with free space for both our chapter show booth as well as space to display the raffle boat and sell raffle tickets.

If you went to the Muskie Expo, you probably got a chance to see the boat we are offering as our first place raffle prize. Thanks to Triton Boats and Frankies Marine we got a really great deal on a Triton 176 Liberty with a 90hp Mercury and Triton Trailer. The second place prize is a \$300 shopping spree at Thorne Bros. Custom Rod & Tackle, third prize is a \$150 shopping spree at Joe's Sporting Goods, and fourth prize is a signed, numbered Live Log print.

We got off to a great start, but we have a long road ahead of us. Even with the great deal we got, we spent \$2000 more than we have ever paid in the past for the grand prize, which means all of us need to step up and sell even more tickets.

We will be mailing out raffle tickets to all of our members the week of April 5th. As in previous years, we will be offering incentive prizes for members who turn in 20 tickets at the May meeting, 40 tickets (an additional 20 tickets) by the June meeting, and 60 tickets total at the July meeting. We will also be offering great prizes to the top sellers including trips to Birch Villa Resort on Cass Lake and Shingwak Resort on Lake of the Woods.

Each chapter (or family) member will be sent 20 raffle tickets. The raffle tickets sell for \$2.00 each. When you are ready for additional tickets, please contact Matt Olson 612-423-2404, or you can pick up more tickets at the meetings.

We have set a goal to raise \$15,000. That means we have to sell 13,500 tickets to hit our goal after expenses. That also means that we will be able to stock even more muskies in metro-area lakes.

## Get the Kids Ready. Spring has Sprung and Fishing's Begun!

Granted, not everyone is into panfish but it is what's available now and if you haven't tried in a while you might want to give it a go. A scrappy crappie on ultralight is still fun (and maybe you'll get your first pike or muskie of the year that grabs the panfish on your line!)

Spring is a great time to take the kids out and wet a line. We still have some time to spare before the gamefish seasons open and what better way to get kids trained in the basics than a boating or shore hunting expedition when the water warms and the bluegills swarm! I loved going panfishing in flooded ditches and shorelines where I grew up in southern Minnesota. You didn't even need a boat. If you had rubber boots to your knees, or waders, you could go explore areas that others couldn't reach. Not only for the 'gills but later on for the numbers of carp (and BIG carp!) that spawn in May.

Now that I've thoroughly blasphemed the muskie-only gods, I might as well cap it off with the fact that bowfin (dog-fish) are as aggressive and fun to catch as they are ugly! Here's our first opportunity to start taking the kids fishing – and even some of their friends. This is where it started for me and I'm sure it was similar for a lot of you as well. Teach them the basics and get them on the path to loving and appreciating the outdoors and fishing!

For those who are willing to volunteer at youth fishing events, there are now a handful of opportunities with the Twin Cities Fish-A-Thon to get kids into fishing. They are a

lot of fun and the reward is seeing kids get excited and want MORE of the outdoors and fishing instead of sitting on their butts in front of the TV. If you can help at only one event, you'll be greatly appreciated and make difference!

- TUESDAY, MAY 22, 6-9 pm – Rod & Reel refurbishing at a Gander Mountain location (probably Lakeville). Equipment collected by Gander Mountain is given to urban kids at the June events.
- FRIDAY, JUNE 8, LAKE CALHOUN, 6-10 am – Kids Fishing and Pastor's Tournament. This will be a media event. People with boats are needed to take the kids fishing.
- SATURDAY, JUNE 9, LAKE CALHOUN – Kids Fishing Day. Food, fun and fishing for kids who would not otherwise get a chance to go fishing. People with boats will be needed this day also.
- SATURDAY, AUGUST 18, LAKE MINNETONKA – Take the Kids Fishing. Again, people with boats to take kids fishing will be needed.
- SATURDAY, AUGUST 25, WHITE BEAR LAKE – Kids Fishing Tournament. People with boats to take kids and parents fishing. Last year my wife and I took one young lad and his father fishing during this tournament. 9-year-old Connor caught a 40+ inch muskie and won first place for the largest fish caught during the tournament.
