Frank Schneider, Jr. Honored by MN DNR


The Minnesota DNR opened a new boat launch this summer dedicated to long-time chapter member and state conservation legend Frank Schneider, Jr. In the spring several benches with plaques will be installed. Next time you fish Mille Lacs look for the new launch at the Liberty Beach public access six miles north of Isle on Highway 47.

Frank Schneider, Jr. was an avid angler, hunter, conservationist and citizen-activist who worked doggedly for Minnesota's hunters and anglers for more than 35 years. He worked tirelessly at the state Capitol and at meeting rooms around the state for the benefit of hunters and anglers. Thanks in part to Frank's hard work Minnesota has perhaps the finest muskie fishing in the nation; commercial fishing nets are no longer used in Rainy Lake and Lake of the Woods for walleyes; most of the state's lakes have public accesses or fishing piers; Minnesota lakes are managed individually with specific fishing regulations rather than lumped altogether; and 27 Minnesota lakes ban winter spearing to protect the muskie population (a controversial position that earned him bullet holes in his fishing boat). Frank also championed catch-and-release fishing for all species.

Stocking Report

The chapter has made a commitment this year to stock 1000 2-year-old muskies into area lakes. The 16-20 inch fish will have a good rate of survival. Current plans include stocking 500 of the fish into White Bear Lake. 300-350 will go into Minnetonka and the remaining fish will be stocked in another area lake to be determined by the DNR.

The 1000 muskies will be purchased from Minnesota Muskie Farm. Proceeds from the Rearing Fund Raffle are used to pay for the fish. A grant to our chapter from the Hugh C. Becker Foundation will be used to purchase the fish this year as the raffle didn't earn enough to purchase the number of fish we committed to.



Summer Fishing League

The Twin Cities Chapter Muskies Inc. summer fishing league has come to a close for the 2008 season. It has been a great success with 30 people taking part in the outings throughout the season on several different lakes. The fish didn't exactly cooperate on the outings, but there were 5 muskies caught. The league winner for 2008 is Eric Schultz. Final league standings are on page 5.

Lake Pokegama was stocked with roughly 2000 fingerlings and will continue to be stocked for the next 10 years. After that time the DNR will evaluate if the population is self-sustaining and adjust their stocking accordingly. Some people that made this happen include: Gary Rutherford and the Star of the North Chapter, John Underhill, Rob Kimm, George Selcke, Carl Peterson, members of the Minnesota Muskie Alliance and all the others that spent time in meetings, making calls and emails. Great job everyone!

Congratulations to Christine Rein on her 51" muskie released August 24th back into White Bear Lake. Looks like the wind was really blowing that day too! This time last year twenty-three 50" and longer fish were released and this year in 2008 eighteen muskie 50" and over were entered in the Members Only Contest. The big fish are still there, we just need to find them and stop imagining they're all gone!!

If you're planning on getting out a couple of more times this year, here are the top five lakes that are kicking out fish: White Bear with 45 fish, Minnetonka with 39 fish, Bald Eagle with 27 fish, Vermilion with 21 fish and finally Lake of the Woods with 20 fish. Looks like the rearing and stocking our chapter has been doing in the top two lakes is really paying off!!

Want to know what to throw: Double Cowgirl with 28 fish, Bucktail with 23 fish, Cowgirl with 22 fish, Bull Dawg Jerk with 20 fish and the Homemade Bucktail with 17 fish. Now we know why they say 80% of all muskie are caught and released on a bucktail!! Who wants to throw a big piece of wood anyway??
