Summer Fishing League Off to a Good Start

The Chapter Fishing League is a way to get members out on the water fishing instead of just talking about it. It's intended as a fun outing with other chapter members. The league is a great way to meet other muskie fishermen, make friendships, and learn more about muskie fishing. If you don't have a boat, come out anyway and we'll match you up.

The first outing had 6 participants out on Forest Lake. The weather was not the best, but Roger Ecklund did catch a 43-incher to start off the league. One other fish lost and several other follows. The second league outing was at Lake Independence June 17. No fish were caught, but we had a better turnout. So far this year, Roger Ecklund leads the league in points.

Scoring is the same as the Member's Only contest: 4 points for a 30" muskie and 1 point for each inch over 30". 5 points will be awarded per event fished, weekend events count 5 points per day. 3 points will be awarded to each boat partner of a successful catch during the league.

We are adding a Metro Chapters Challenge to the league this season between our chapter and North Metro, most likely in September. It will be on a Saturday morning, most likely followed by a picnic. Details still need to be worked out between the clubs, so more info to follow. Any members will be able to take part in the outing.

Two Fundraising Tournaments for the Chapter in 2009

This year the Twin Cities chapter will be holding two muskie tournaments: The Frank Schneider Jr. Memorial Tournament in northern Minnesota and the George Wahl Memorial Tournament in the metro area.

42nd Annual Frank Schneider Memorial Muskie Tournament

This is Muskies Inc.'s oldest fishing contest. For over 40 years our chapter has been holding a tournament in northern Minnesota. The first tournament was on Cass Lake and the event has grown to include 21 lakes in the Bemidji-Walker-Cass Lake-Longville area of northern Minnesota. In the 1990s the tournament was re-named to honor Frank Schneider Jr., long-time Muskies Inc. member who worked tirelessly with the legislature and other outdoor organizations to improve fishing and hunting opportunities in the state.

This year's tournament will be September 11, 12 & 13. With over \$30,000 in prizes, it promises to be a great event. The grand prize, a Skeeter 1790T boat/trailer with a Yamaha 75 hp 4-stroke was obtained through Frankies Marine in Chisago City, a long-time supporter of Muskies Inc. and Skeeter Boats. Anyone who registers a muskie 40" or longer will be eligible for the grand prize drawing. The winner will be able to use the boat in trade for any other boat from Frankies.

Included with the registration is three days of muskie fishing on your choice of 21 lakes, feeds Friday and Saturday nights, and an awards program and feed at Moondance Fairgrounds in Walker on Sunday. Bill Sherck, "The Man About The Woods" from Minnesota Bound will host Sunday's Awards Program.

Prizes will be awarded through 10th place for

released muskies with the top three juniors also receiving prizes. Fenwick rods, Abu Garcia reels, and other fishing equipment as well as trips to Canadian and US resorts are part of the prize package. A trip to Red Wing Lodge on Lake of the Woods will go to the first place finisher.

The event will also feature silent auctions at the feeds as well as a tournament-only raffle with guide trips, custom fishing equipment, and other great prizes.

Information will be mailed in mid-July to anyone who has fished the tournament in the past three years. You may register by mailing in the form that comes in the mail, on the chapter website, www.twincitiesmuskiesinc.org, or in person before September 3 at Thorne Bros. in Fridley, Joe's in St. Paul, Blue Ribbon Bait & Tackle in Oakdale, Reed's Family Outdoor Outfitters in Walker, One Stop in Longville, Froggie's Bait & Tackle in Cass Lake, or Bluewater Bait in Bemidji.

All chapter members are encouraged to fish this event, as it funds the operating budget for the chapter each year.

1st Annual George Wahl Memorial Metro-Area Muskie Tournament

The George Wahl Memorial Tournament was conceived this year for several reasons. First was that your chapter board wanted a way to honor George, his love of muskies and muskie fishing, his contribution to the muskie fishing industry, his generosity sharing information with others, and his encouragement to muskie anglers.

We have been holding a tournament in northern Minnesota for over 40 years and have increasingly found it gets harder and more expensive for chapter members to get away for three days of fishing up north. The George Wahl tournament is a one-day, metro-area event. Every local chapter member should participate in this tournament.

100% of the proceeds raised by this event will go to improve the local metro-area muskie fishery. This year the DNR has designated stocking approximately 700 muskies in White Bear Lake and Lake Minnetonka. It costs \$15 for each muskie fingerling stocked. Yearling muskies cost \$25-\$30 apiece.

Every person who catches a muskie will be eligible for the grand prize, a trip for 4 people to Whitefish Bay Camp on Lake of the Woods. Prizes will be awarded through 10th place and to the three top-placing juniors. A Mary Villnow Memorial cash bonus will be awarded to the top three female anglers. The Mary Villnow bonus was created to encourage women muskie anglers of all ages. The Fly Angler will also offer a bonus for the biggest muskie caught on a fly. The awards program will be held at Thorne Bros. in Fridley and will include a "feed" for all contestants. We hope to see all chapter members on October 3.



The June meeting was a combined Swap Meet and Family Night. Our youth partner Fishing For Life had games and other events for kids. The kids had a great time and those who participated went home with some great bargains.
