



43rd Frank Schneider Memorial Muskie Tournament

The Frank Schneider Tournament, Muskies Inc.'s oldest fishing contest, will take place September 10, 11 & 12. For over 40 years our chapter has been holding a tournament in northern Minnesota. In the 1990s the tournament was re-named to honor Frank Schneider Jr., long-time Muskies Inc. member who worked tirelessly with the legislature and other outdoor organizations to improve fishing and hunting opportunities in the state.

21 Lakes Included in Tournament

Tournament anglers can fish their choice of 21 northern Minnesota lakes. Tournament waters include Leech Lake, Baby Lake, Man Lake, Woman Lake, Girl Lake, Lake Wabedo, Little Boy Lake, Rice Lake, Boy River, Lake Inguadona, Boy Lake, Swift Lake, Lake Andrusia, Kitchie Lake, Wolf Lake, Buck Lake, Cass Lake, Pike Bay, Big Lake, Lake Winnibigoshish, and Lake Bemidji.

This is not a big-time team event. Each participant has equal chance to make the top ten. Entry includes three days of muskie fishing, feeds Friday and Saturday nights, and an awards program and feed at Moon dance Fairgrounds in Walker on Sunday. Bill Sherck, from TV's Due North Outdoors and Minnesota Bound will host Sunday's program.

Over \$35,000 in Prizes

Anyone who registers a 40" or longer muskie is entered in the drawing for the grand prize, a Skeeter ZX190 with a Yamaha 150. The boat/motor/ trailer package came from Skeeter Boats and Frankies Marine in Chisago City, a long-time supporter of Muskies Inc. The grand prize boat will be on display at Northern Lights Casino, Walker, tournament partner during August.

With over \$35,000 in prizes, it promises to be a great event. Prizes will be awarded through 10th place for released muskies with the top three juniors also receiving prizes. The first-place finisher will receive a week-long trip to Red Wing Lodge on Lake of the Woods. Fenwick rods, Abu Garcia reels, and other tackle as well as trips to Canadian and US resorts are part of the prize packages.

The event will also feature opportunities for everyone to win Canadian and US resort stays, guide trips, custom fishing equipment, and door prizes.

Registration Now Open

Tournament entry is \$95, \$30 for juniors and \$175 for a family package of two adults and two juniors or one adult and three juniors in the same family. If you've participated in the Frank Schneider Tournament in the past three years, you should receive tournament information in the mail. Enter the tournament by sending back the form from the mailing, on-line at the chapter website www.twincitiesmuskiesinc.org, or in person before September 3 at Thorne Bros. in Blaine, Joe's in St. Paul, Blue Ribbon Bait & Tackle in Oakdale, Reed's Family Outdoor Outfitters in Walker, and One Stop in Longville. Tournament entries will be available at the August picnic.

The tournament funds the chapter's operating budget for the year. Funds raised provide for the brats, burgers and pop at the Minnehaha Falls picnic for our next meeting, the speakers we enjoy at our general meetings, production of the newsletter, and everything else that keeps the chapter running.

We hope to see all our chapter members at the Frank Schneider Memorial Tournament. For most contestants this is the only tournament they fish in during the year. Join the people who keep coming back year after year for the tradition, comradery and fun.

The August 10 meeting will be our annual Pot Luck Summer Picnic at Minnehaha Falls Park. Burgers, brats, buns and pop will be provided by the chapter. Everyone should bring a side dish or dessert to share.

Minaki-Winnepig River Chapter Outing Yields Over 30 Muskies

Fourteen muskie anglers experienced a memorable week at Paradise Cove Resort in northwest Ontario the week of July 17-24. The group had 78% success in boating and releasing 38 muskies. The biggest was a 53-incher caught by Pat McCalister on his revolutionary "COOT" bait! Eighteen muskies between 40-50 inches were boated – one at 49 inches, two at 47 inches, one at 46 inches, two at 45 inches, one at 44 inches, two at 43 inches, one at 41 inches and five 40-inchers. Sixteen muskies between 30-40 inches and three between 24-30 inches were also boated by the group. Besides the ones that were caught/released, the group raised at least a dozen "tankers" from 50-56 inches.

Most of the group have already committed to return next year. Plan on joining them as there was space for more people. Eric Bakke will be organizing this event which will probably take place July 16-23, 2011.

Summer Fishing League

Greg Kappas is still leading the Summer Fishing League outings in points with his 45.5" from the first outing in June at Forest Lake. No fish have been caught since that first outing. The field is open for anyone to take. Join in for the August 24 outing on Minnetonka. The league is intended as a fun outing with other chapter members and is open to anyone who wants to take part. Kid's Fishing Contest

Have fun, go fishing with a kid and help them learn about different species of fish. Children 12 and under as of January 1 who are members or have a parent or guardian who is a member of the Twin Cities Chapter are eligible to participate in our Kids Fishing Contest. The rules are simple. All fish must be caught by using legal means and the fish must be witnessed by a parent or another adult.

An award will be given to every child who catches a panfish, catfish, carp, bass, walleye, or pike of any size. Special note will be made for catches of: 5 or more bluegills, perch and/or sunfish in one day; a catfish, bullhead or carp; or a smallmouth bass, largemouth

bass, walleye or sauger of 12 inches or more or a northern pike of 18 inches or more. Muskies 30 inches or more will qualify for the Junior Division of the Members Only Contest. Muskies less than 30 inches don't qualify for any contest.

An award will be given to each and every child who satisfies the criteria for at least one of the ten categories. One entry per child should be submitted for the entire 2010 fishing season. Be sure to keep track of your child's catches all on one form. Include anything special about a fish or a trip (1st fish, biggest fish or most fish in one day, Grandpa's secret spot, caught more than Dad, etc.).

KIDS FISHING CONTEST

Don't forget to keep a record this summer of the fish caught by the 12-and-under set for our Kids

Fishing Contest. The rules are simple. All fish - any species - must be caught by using legal means and the fish must be witnessed by a parent or another adult. An award will be given to each and every child whose parent or guardian turns in their fish list. One entry per child should be submitted for the entire 2010 fishing season. Be sure to keep track of your child's catches all on one form. Include anything special about a fish or a trip (1st fish, biggest fish or most fish in one day, Grandpa's secret spot, caught more than Dad, etc.).

NEW BOATING LAW

A new state law requires boaters to drain water before leaving any state waters or face fines up to \$1000. Boaters are required to:

- Remove aquatic plants and zebra mussels from boats and trailers.
- Drain all water including pulling the drain plug, open other water draining devices, and drain bilges and livewells.

It is now illegal to trailer a boat on a public road with the drain plug in.

George Wahl Memorial Tournament is October 2

The second annual George Wahl tournament will be held Saturday, October 2 on 13 metro-area muskie waters. 100% of the proceeds raised by this event will go to improve the local metro-area muskie fishery.

The tournament was conceived as a way to honor George, his love of muskies and muskie fishing, his contribution to the muskie fishing industry, his generosity sharing information with others, and his encouragement to muskie anglers.

Prizes will be awarded through 10th place and to the top-placing juniors. There will be opportunities for everyone to win resort stays, guide trips, a custom Thornes Bros. rod and many other prizes.

The grand prize winner will be able to fish George's favorite fishing waters – Whitefish Bay on Lake of the Woods. A week-long stay at Whitefish Bay Camp for 4 people plus \$1000 cash is the grand prize. Every person

who enters a muskie is eligible for the grand prize drawing.

A Mary Villnow Memorial cash bonus – created to encourage women muskie anglers of all ages – will be awarded to the top three female anglers. The Fly Angler will offer a \$250 bonus for the biggest muskie caught using a fly.

The awards program will be held at Thorne Bros. in Blaine and will include a "feed" for all participants. We hope to see every chapter member on October 2.

The George Wahl tournament is a fun way to contribute to the muskie fishery that we all use and enjoy. It costs \$15 for each muskie fingerling stocked. Yearling muskies cost \$25-\$30 apiece. Funds provided by the first George Wahl tournament last year went toward stocking approximately 700 muskies in White Bear Lake and Lake Minnetonka.
