Chapter Members Only Contest

Another season is in the record books. Was your season everything you wanted it to be? There were some among us who had great seasons and there were some who had a rough go of it. That is the great thing about these fish, there is always someone out there who is catching them no matter how tough we think the fishing is.

No matter what your personal success, the Lunge Log is a tool we can use so we can go back and crunch some numbers to see what worked and where people were having some success, even if you didn't.

Here are some numbers from this last season from the Lunge Log. As a chapter we registered 219 muskies from 4 states/provinces and 35 lakes/rivers. We had an average of 40.39 inches per fish – 50's - 13, 40's - 110 and 30's - 96. By month (catch numbers): April - 3, June - 23, July - 48, August - 39, September - 40, October - 62, and November - 3. By month (average size): April - 37.7", June - 39.6", July - 41.6", August - 39.6", September - 39.5", October - 40.8", and November - 42.9". The top lakes were: Lake Minnetonka - 58, Lake of the Woods - 53, Bald Eagle Lake - 15, Lake Bemidji - 13, and Lake Vermillion - 12. The top lure types: Bucktails - 67, Crankbaits - 64, Jerkbait - 46, Spinner - 16, surface - 7.

Our largest fish and winner of a replica from Lax Reproductions is Peter Janik with a 54.5-incher from Lake Minnetonka on July 13. We will present Peter with his replica at our Sportsman's Banquet in March.

So looking at all this info, I think I am going to put myself on the water in July/November on Lake Minnetonka with a bucktail. That should guarantee me a fish, right? Whether it works for me or not next year, it didn't prove to be my path to victory amongst my peers this last season.
