Vince Trotta Honored with Chapter Muskie Award

he Muskie Award is presented by our chapter each year to a member who has given of their time and talents to the chapter and/or Muskies, Inc. The first Muskie Award was presented in 1974 to Muskies Inc. founder, Gil Hamm. The Twin Cities chapter has continued to present this award ever since. Vince Trotta was awarded this year's Muskie Award. It was presented to him at the recent Muskies, Inc. 50th Anniversary Celebration Banquet.

Vince has been a member of our chapter since 1990 and served on the Board of Directors. He was part of the group that established the History and Archives committee for national Muskies Inc. in 2006. The committee collected and organized available Muskies Inc. historical documents and artifacts. The collection includes the Gil Hamm family scrapbook, thousands of pictures and videos, Muskies, Inc. correspondence and advertisements, Gil Hamm's fishing rods; Muskies, Inc. financial records, historic lure and equipment collections as well as copies of the Muskies, Inc. Newsletter/Muskie magazines. For 10 years the Muskies Inc. archives was stored at this house.

He assisted in researching, preparing displays, locating and inviting founding members, and preparing speeches for Muskies, Inc. 40th Anniversary celebration. Vince has served as photographer, along with Juris Ozols, for Twin Cities chapter activities. The many, many photos are digitally stored in the archives.

George's Minnesota Muskie Expo April 8, 9, 10

on't miss George's Minnesota Muskie Expo April 8-10 at Ganglehoff Center, Concordia University in St. Paul. The Expo was founded over 20 years ago by George Wahl, inventor and manufacturer of the Eagle Tail lure. The three-day event is dedicated to muskies and muskie fishing – featuring some of the world's top muskie anglers sharing secrets of success in seminars, retailers offering great sale prices, as well as guides and resorts. The unique aspect of the Expo is being able to buy direct from lure manufacturers, getting low prices, custom colors and the newest prototype baits.

A large "Kids Midway" area with games and prizes for kids is provided by Fishing for Life. At George's Tackle Box, kids can make their own lures and take them home.

Seminars this year feature a Minnesota Guide Panel, Jim Saric, Luke Ronnestrand on Friday; Josh Stevenson, Johnny Dadson, Gregg Thomas and a seminar on Fly Fishing for Muskies on Saturday; and a Bait Makers Panel, Jeff Anderson/John Hoyer, and Mike Keyes on Sunday.

The Expo is open from 2 to 9 pm Friday, from 10 am to 7 pm on Saturday, and on Sunday from 10 am to 4 pm. Kids 12 and under are free, so bring the whole family. Entry to the Expo is the same as it was when the Expo first started. Adult entry is \$10 per day, a three-day pass is \$17. Expo information can be found online at: mnmuskieexpo.com.

ummer Fishing league starts Sunday, June 5 at Forest Lake. The chapter's Fishing League will use the same rules as last year. Points are awarded for fish caught and are accumulated through the season. Minimum size to qualify is 36". A 36" fish is 10 points. Fish are measured to the nearest half inch but you must be over, so a 42½" earns 16½ points.

Participants can choose to participate for cash prizes. The top two point-getters will be paid out. If we have over 15 participants three placess will be paid. A \$50 donation to the chapter stocking and rearing fund is required to be eligible to receive one of the cash prizes.

Travel from the U.S. to Manaus, tips for guides and staff (est. \$350.00) and cost related to additional time spent in travel are not included.






