## Outing with Capable Partners

An outing with members of the Capable Partners organization is planned for Sunday, June 5 from 6:30 am to “shore lunch” time on Lake Minnetonka. Capable Partners is a non-profit organization that provides hunting, fishing, and related opportunities for physically-challenged individuals.

Share your love for the pursuit of muskies with a fellow outdoorsman. Volunteers are needed to take guests out for a morning of fishing. About one-half of participants will need space for wheelchairs, but any size boat can be matched with one of the Capable Partners.

Meet at Surfside Park in Mound on Cook's Bay at 6:30 am. We will load up the boats and spend the morning muskie fishing.

You don't have to go fishing to join in. A “shore lunch” will end the event and help is needed to cook or serve as well. And if you show up, you might be lucky enough to have someone with a boat invite you to continue fishing in the afternoon.

If anyone has portable folding tables to bring, that is also a help as they are easier for wheelchairs to use than the standard picnic tables with fixed seating.

## Veteran's Home Fishing Opener

Residents of the Minneapolis Veteran's Home are looking forward to their “Fishing Opener” on Saturday, May 7 complete with fishing and shore lunch. Our chapter, along with several VFW, American Legion, and AmVets Posts have sponsored this event for over 20 years at the Minnesota Veteran's Home.

A large, well-stocked trout pond will be set up in the yard at the home and residents will be able to come down to the pond and spend the morning fishing for the trout. Volunteers will prepare a shore lunch of fresh-caught trout, potatoes and beans and serve it to the veterans.

If you don't attend any other chapter event, this one is well worth it. The fishing opener event has been recognized for being one of the best volunteer events at Veterans Homes all over the country. It's extremely rewarding to see our veterans who may never get the chance any other time during the year to come out and get some fishing in. Many of them are lined up waiting bright and early in the morning.

Volunteers are needed to help residents with the fishing, cleaning the fish, cooking and serving the meal, and generally making this a fun event. Last year we served many hundreds of meals to residents and their families and caregivers. It takes a lot of people to make this happen for the residents.

# Chapter Summer Fishing League

We welcome all chapter members to join in the Summer Fishing League this season. At least 2 league events are planned for summer/fall months except July when water temps tend to be too high. The league will use the same format as last year. You must be a paid up member of the Twin Cities chapter of Muskies Inc. to qualify.

Points are awarded for fish caught and are accumulated through the season. Minimum size to qualify is 36". A 36" fish is 10 points. Fish are measured to the nearest half inch but you must be over, so a 42½" earns 16½ points.

A picture of the fish caught on a board must be submitted by email to TCMI.fishingleague@gmail.com for verification. The fish must be on the board with head touching the upright panel or zero mark and tail towards the higher numbers. Angler should be behind the board so he/she is recognized and the fish is clearly visible. You must be able to see fish's nose touching the upright panel and its tail at the measurement to be accepted. If the length cannot be clearly viewed the fish will be ruled to be 36 inches and 10 points will be awarded.

You do not have to start at specified time but only fish caught between scheduled league times will count. Any cheating reported or observed may result in league disqualification.

In the case of a tie, the most fish submitted will be the first tie breaker. The longest fish will be the second tie breaker. The first fish caught will be third tie breaker.

Summer League anglers can choose to participate for cash prizes. Cash will be paid out to the top two point-getters. If we have over 15 participants three places will be paid.

A \$50 donation to the chapter stocking and rearing fund is required to be eligible to receive one of the cash prizes. Your donation can be made at any time during the season, but only points accumulated after donation is made will qualify for the cash pay out.

We hope to see more chapter members participate in the Summer League this year, whether or not you choose to participate for the cash prizes. The first league event of the season is Sunday, June 5 at Forest Lake.

# Stocking Update

Spring is here and we're counting the days until the opener. Spring is always a busy time for the DNR. All their work begins now, egg stripping, hatching, stocking, lake population assessments and many other programs.

I have had the opportunity to work with them and have seen firsthand how busy they are and how hard they work. At times they could use a helping hand with some of their projects. If you would like to volunteer to work with the DNR on any of the projects, please contact me at 651-592-9257. I'll try to let you know about dates and times the DNR will need help.

Our chapter has already been busy supporting the DNR and their stocking efforts. Last year the DNR had a successful year with musky production, making all their quotas and even wintering over 1,000 extra muskies. Our chapter helped these muskies by purchasing 100 gallons of minnows to feed them during the winter. I am happy to announce that they all made it through and have already been harvested and stocked. 500 went into Bald Eagle and 500 were stocked into White Bear Lake.

The Twin Cities chapter has also helped at the East Metro hatchery with a new condensate tank and supplying dollars for additional energy costs. These efforts were financed by the chapter and a Hugh C. Becker Foundation grant.

Recently we also purchased a pair of electro fish handling gloves that will be used by East Metro Fisheries specialist Joel Steras for his telemetry studies on the St. Croix River.

The outlook for Minnesota muskies looks good and hopefully the egg taking and hatching projects will be successful again this year. But you never know what Ma Nature will throw at us. Stay tuned!

## **June Muskie Tournaments**

Just as the season starts, there are two opportunities to show your muskie fishing prowess. Or, maybe just go out and have some fun with other muskie anglers. The Metro Muskie Tournament and the June Jam offer you a great opportunity to get started for the season. Neither of these events is extremely competitive, mostly just a good time.

### **Metro Muskie Tournament, June 11**

The Metro Muskie Tournament gives you a choice of over 20 metro-area waters to fish. Entries will be available after May 15 at Gander Mountain in Blaine, Thorne Bros. or Blue Ribbon Bait & Tackle through Friday, June 10. A printable form to mail in by June 2 can be found on the tournament site: [www.metromuskietournament.com](http://www.metromuskietournament.com). Entry fee is \$35 per person. All muskies caught will qualify for the grand prize, a one week stay at Musky Bay Resort on Crow Lake, Ontario, a Slammer lure package, and a Fenwick rod with Abu Garcia reel. ### **June Jam, June 18-19**

North Metro's annual tournament, the June Jam, is held on seven muskie lakes in Polk County, Wisconsin – Bone, Cedar, Deer, Round, Wapogasset, Blake and the Apple River Flowage – with a full day of fishing on Saturday and a half day on Sunday. Tournament headquarters will be at Wilkin's Bar and Resort on Bone Lake. Entry is now open for this year's tournament. Entry fee is \$50 per person. ## **Armed Forces Family Fishing Celebration**

**T**he 8th annual Armed Forces Family Fishing Celebration on Friday, June 24 on Lake Minnetonka is a collaborative effort with Fishing for Life and the Twin Cities chapter of Muskies Inc. This event is exclusively for military personnel and their families. They will be taken out for a morning of multi-species fishing.

We are looking for volunteers from our chapter to guide military families and safely bring everyone back to the dock. Fishing is from 7 am to around 11 am. Worms and larva will be provided to groups who want to fish for panfish. Youngsters under 12 will be accompanied by an adult. Loaner equipment is provided for those who don't have their own, but most families have their own equipment. There is great shore fishing at this location while participants wait for their turn for a boat.

Volunteers should arrive at Mound City Park between 6:30 and 7 am for registration and free donuts. Everyone will fish all morning, then be treated to a great meal. Following will be an awards ceremony with trophies and medals for youth participants. The event ends around 1 pm.

In the past, there were more guides from the bass organizations than there were from Muskies Inc. who is a sponsor of the event. So please think about taking a morning to guide these kids and their family members.

The Armed Forces Family Fishing Celebration will take place rain or shine. It will only be cancelled if there is lightning or torrential rain. We hope to see more Muskies Inc. guides out on the lake than those from other organizations.

### Peacock Bass Fishing on the Amazon River
