Andy Wayt Presented Chapter's Muskie Award

The Muskie Award is presented each year to a deserving chapter member who has constantly and unselfishly devoted time and energy over the years to promoting and improving the goals of Muskies, Inc.

The first Muskie Award was presented to Muskies, Inc. founder, Gil Hamm in 1974. The chapter has continued to present the award each year. The Muskie Award for 2017 was presented to Andy Wayt at the annual Sportsman's Banquet on January 27.

Andy is one of the cogs that allows our club to work as well as it does. After joining Muskies, Inc., he volunteered to be a member of the chapter Board of Directors in 2014 and became our chapter treasurer in 2015. Beside helping on almost all club activities, he has been on the Frank Schneider tournament committee for the past two years focusing on the finances and rules. And, he doesn't even get to fish the tournament. This past year or more he has been dealing with an IRS audit of Muskies, Inc. and working on the 501(c)3 status. No fun. This is a big deal. Congratulations to Andy! We appreciate all the work that he has done.

Two Chapter Members To Be Inducted Into Muskies, Inc. Hall of Fame

The national organization of Muskies, Inc. selects individuals to the Muskies, Inc. Hall of Fame who have demonstrated "distinguished service in making the vision of Gil Hamm come true". This year chapter members Vince Trotta and Terrie DuBe´ have been honored with induction into the Hall of Fame.

Vince has been a member of our chapter since 1990 and served on the Board of Directors. As part of the Muskies, Inc. 40th Anniversary celebration in 2006, Vince spent many hours helping to research the organization's history, preparing displays, locating and inviting founding members to the event. As a result of all this work, Vince became the chairman of the newly established national History and Archives Committee for Muskies, Inc. The committee collected and organized available Muskies, Inc. historical documents and artifacts.

The collection includes Gil Hamm family scrapbooks, and other Hamm memorabilia; Hugh C. Becker scrapbooks and memorabilia; Muskies, Inc. correspondence and advertisements; historic lure and equipment collections; and many, many other artifacts as well as 50 years of multiple copies of early Muskies, Inc. Newsletters and *Muskie* magazines.

George’s Minnesota Muskie Expo is March 9, 10, 11

Don’t miss George’s Minnesota Muskie Expo March 9-11 at Ganglehoff Center, Concordia University in St. Paul. The Expo was founded over 20 years ago by chapter member George Wahl, inventor and manufacturer of the Eagle Tail lure. The three-day event is dedicated to muskies and muskie fishing – featuring some of the world’s top muskie anglers sharing secrets of success in seminars, retailers offering great sale prices, as well as guides and resorts. The unique aspect of the Expo is being able to buy direct from lure manufacturers, getting low prices, custom colors and the newest prototype baits.

A large “Kids Midway” area with games and prizes for kids is provided by Fishing for Life. At George’s Tackle Box, kids can make their own lures and take them home. Seminars this year feature Ryan McMahon, Mike Keyes and Gregg Thomas on Friday; Luke Ronnestrand, Jim Saric, John Hoyer and Adam Glickman on Saturday; and on Sunday a Minnesota Guide Panel, Steve Heiting and Steve Worrell.

The Expo is open from 2 to 9 pm Friday, from 10 am to 7 pm on Saturday, and on Sunday from 10 am to 4 pm. Kids 12 and under are free, so bring the whole family. A great honor to Terrie who lost her courageous battle with cancer before she was able to receive this well-deserved recognition.
