If you've ever fished for muskies in a metro-area lake, do your part for this fishery. Make plans to participate in the 10th annual George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament on September 29. The price of your entry to participate in the tournament guarantees funds to be able to stock at least one muskie in a metro-area lake. One hundred percent of the proceeds will be put back into the local metro-area muskie fishery.

Funds raised at the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament have enabled the Twin Cities chapter to purchase and stock close to 10,000 muskie fingerlings in White Bear Lake, Bald Eagle Lake, Lake Independence, Lake Waconia, Lake Minnetonka, and the St. Croix River over the past several years. The chapter has also been able to provide funds to the Minnesota DNR to purchase equipment for their hatcheries and to provide pit and floy tags for their studies on stocking.

Tournament anglers have their choice of 13 metro-area lakes:
Minnetonka, Independence, Waconia, Eagle (Hennepin County), White Bear, Bald Eagle, Owasso, Forest, Harriet, Calhoun, Lake of the Isles, Cedar and the St. Croix River. Tournament hours are from 7 am to 5:30 pm.

First place is \$1000 cash. Second and third places will also win cash. Prizes, including Thorne Bros. Gift

Te've had some constant conditions with a lack of rain throughout most of August. We had a lot of smaller lakes well over 80 degrees for a lot of the month. Nights are starting to have that fall feel, days are getting shorter, and plenty of fish are being registered by Chapter One members.

I hate to admit this but it looks like John Newman has been right all along, there is no need to troll (at least this August). Only two fish all month came from outside casting, and one was drifting with a jig! Fish are coming out of all bottom types and structure. The two most popular seem to be sand and junk weeds, but not by much. Natural colored baits dominated the registered fish, with black bucktails being a notable force to reckon with. A lot more fish this month have been eating crank baits as well.

The most notable August catches have been Nolen Ryba with a (48.5" and 47.5"), Matt McDonald (50"), Linda Knutson (50") and the man taking the August cake so far, Tom Batina (52").

There is a lot of good fishing to be had in the near future and as I write this article. The Chapter Challenge is underway, the Frank Schneider is nearly approaching, and the George Wahl is right around the corner. White Bear, Bald Eagle and Minnetonka Tagged Muskies



uskies stocked in Lake Minnetonka, Bald Eagle Lake and White Bear Lake for several years are part of a multi-year DNR study on stocking. All muskies stocked in those lakes have a small yellow tag near the dorsal fin. When fishing those lakes, you should be looking for fish that have the yellow tags. By this time, the tags may be covered with algae and other material, so look closely.

If you see a yellow tag on any muskie, the DNR needs data from you to complete the study. DO NOT REMOVE THE YELLOW TAG. It is important that they get data on the re-catchability of fish. They will need the number on the yellow tag, the name of the lake, and the length of the fish. They would also appreciate your name and phone number in case they need to follow-up. 

Fishing Pressure and Muskies






