More Waters Added to the Schneider Memorial Tournament

Mantrap Lake, Lake Benedict and the Mississippi River between Lake Bemidji and Lake Winnibigoshish have been added to the northern Minnesota waters that participants may choose to fish for the 2019 Frank Schneider, Jr. Memorial Muskie Tournament this September 6, 7, and 8. Started by Muskies, Inc. founder Gil Hamm in 1967 as a competitive chapter get-together, 3-day event maintains the get-together feel but has since evolved into one of the largest, most progressive events in the world of muskie fishing. This Catch-Photo-Release tournament gives every contestant a shot at boating a true giant as well as winning some awesome prizes.

Also new this year is a tournament-only raffle. Tickets will be sold only during the tournament and pre-registration. Prizes include week stay at Canadian resorts, a Revo Beast reel and Simms bibs/jacket rain gear. Only 250 tickets will be printed and when they're sold out, they're sold out.

The \$15,000 Grand Prize will be divided into three equal payouts, essentially tripling the odds of winning some good money for contestants who register a qualifying 40-inch or longer muskie. The grand prize total amount is figured on a sliding scale. The \$15,000 amount is based on a field of 500 paid entrants. If there are less than 500 entrants, the total cash amount will

be less than \$15,000. If the number of entrants exceeds 500, the total cash amount will be more.

At the end of tournament hours Friday and Saturday, there will be four feed/registration stations spread across the tournament area for participants to register their fish, use their \$10 voucher for food and/or beverage, and mingle with other participants. Whether you are fortunate enough to register a fish or not, the feeds are worth stopping out for.

After tournament hours on Sunday, the Awards program will be held at the Northern Lights Casino and Events Center. This event brings all contestants together and provides everyone with a great time to reflect on the weekend of fishing and good times over

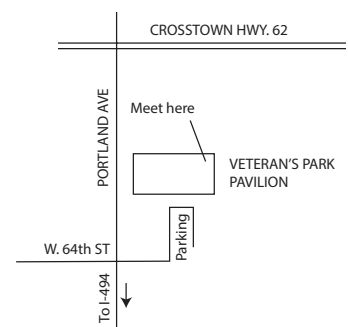

People are needed at the tournament to: distribute tournament packets to participants on Thursday, September 5, at three locations, work 2-3 hours at the Friday and Saturday feeds at five locations taking in fish registration forms and checking downloaded photos, tally fish caught as they are called in, as well as the 20+ workers needed at the Sunday program. We are two months into the Minnesota fishing season and temperatures are already touching the 80s in many parts of the metro. Fishing has been down compared to last year. Number of catches are down, and the big girls have definitely steered clear of any hooks.

In comparison, in 2018 we had 15 fish over 48 inches caught by the time of writing the July article. This year we only have three, highlighted most recently by Colin Hulke (52.75") in July on Minnetonka, as well as Brent Lenke (57.5" and 53") June fish on Mille Lacs.

Baits and structure this year seem to be a little different from last year as well. A lot of fish are getting caught over boulders, and by the means of crank baits. Rubber baits have almost been nonexistent with fish registries this year as well. Last year seemed like many of the fish were coming by blades in July.

Another note, the metro has been extremely light on fish registered. We have only three of the 17 fish registered from the metro. On top of that, it only seems we have had one July Canada trip, which spring-boarded Ethan Stout to the top of the Men's Division.

Best of luck on the water as we try to turn this cold July around into a hot August.

George Wahl Tournament: Supporting the Local Muskie Fishery

Our chapter's second fundraising tournament, the 11th annual George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament will be held on September 28 on 12 lakes in the metro area. One hundred percent of the proceeds from the tournament will be put back into the local metro-area muskie fishery.

First place is \$1000 cash. Prizes, including Thorne Bros. Gift Certificates

are awarded through 5th place. Every person who registers a muskie during the tournament is entered into a drawing for the Grand Prize – a trip to Whitefish Bay Camp on Lake of the Woods and \$500.

Tournament hours are from 7 am to 6 pm. Tournament headquarters and the Awards program will be at Thorne Bros. in Blaine. There will be raffles

and other opportunities to win items to take home.

Entry for the tournament is \$50, a small price to pay to ensure that the quality of our local fishery will continue for years to come. If you've ever fished for muskies in a metro-area lake, do your part for this fishery. Participate in the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament.

Look for Tagged Muskies in White Bear, Bald Eagle and Tonka

Muskies stocked in Lake Minnetonka, Bald Eagle Lake and White Bear Lake for several years are part of a multi-year DNR study



on stocking. All muskies stocked in those lakes have a small yellow tag near the dorsal fin. When fishing those lakes, you should be looking for fish that have the yellow tags. By this time, the tags may be covered with algae and other material, so look closely.

If you see a yellow tag on any muskie, the DNR needs data from you to complete the study. DO NOT REMOVE THE YELLOW TAG. It is

important that they get data on the re-catchability of fish. They will need the number on the yellow tag, the name of the lake, and the length of the fish. They would also appreciate your name and phone number in case they need to follow-up. a hot meal. There will be drawings for door prizes, and raffles with fishing tackle, lures and outdoor equipment so everyone has a chance to take home something. Bonuses will be awarded to the top 3 ladies, the top 3 fish caught using an Abu Garcia reel, the top 3 fish caught fly fishing, the person who netted the largest fish, and all those who registered a 50-inch or longer muskie. Lastly, we will draw for the three winners of the grand prize payouts.

One of the tournament requirements again this year is that you take a photo of your fish on a commercially-

manufactured bump board. We will have a limited number of bump boards for sale at \$75. If you want to reserve one, you should pre-register.

Registration Opens August 10

There are three different ways to sign up for the Schneider Memorial Tournament: in-person, by mail, or online. You can register in person until Labor Day (September 2) at Blue Ribbon, Joe's Sporting Goods, and Thorne Bros. in the Twin Cities, or at Reed's in Walker and One Stop in Longville.

Everyone who fished in the tournament for the past three years will be mailed tournament information that will include an entry form that can be mailed in. Or you can visit our website to print out an entry form. Entries must be mailed by August 25.

The third, and hopefully most convenient, option is to use our updated online registration. The registration site is mobile friendly, so you can sign up for the event right from your phone. You can find the registration link on the chapter website, twincitiesmuskiesinc.org or on our Facebook page. Online registration is open through Wednesday, September 3, though after September 1 your options for packet pickup locations become limited.

Cost to enter the three-day event is \$100 for adults, \$30 for juniors, and \$180 for a family of 2 adults and 2 juniors or 1 adult and 3 juniors. Labor Day the cost goes to \$120 adults, \$40 juniors and \$200 family package.

Feel free to make every effort to sign up as early as possible! It will help us administratively and not only will you save on entry fees, you will be able to pre-order tournament hats, t-shirts, raffle ticket and bump boards.

You will also be able to register in person on Thursday, September 5 at Reed's until 5:30 pm and from 6-10 pm at Northern Lights Casino in Walker, all day at One Stop in Longville and from 3-8 pm at Destination Sports in Bemidji.

For students and people who cannot get away on Friday, we have a 2-day Saturday/Sunday option. 2-day entry is \$80 for adults, \$20 for juniors, and \$150 for a family package before Labor Day and goes up to \$100/\$30/170 after Labor Day.

The Frank Schneider tournament is one of the chapter's primary fundraisers, providing funds for stocking efforts and all of our chapter's other activities.

Make this September a win-win. Call up that old boat partner and come make some memories up in the Bemidji/Leech Lake/Longville area while supporting your Twin Cities chapter of Muskies, Inc!
