Frank Schneider Memorial Muskie Tournament – COVID Pandemic Cannot Stop Tournament

Under COVID restrictions the Muskie-fishing bubble ascended on the legendary muskie waters of northern Minnesota with 480 anglers fishing the 53rd Frank Schneider Jr. Memorial Muskie Tournament. Impressive numbers against the ongoing COVID pandemic, equaling contestant numbers from the past few years. Thanks to all contestants taking part to make the tournament a great success!!!

Congratulations to winner Ethan Stout who won the event catching four muskies of 45.25, 40.5, 40, and 48 inches from Mantrap Lake. In addition to the Abu Garcia Beast reel, Fenwick Techna/Predator rod, and new Berkley line courtesy of Pure Fishing and Reeds Family Outdoor Outfitters that all 10 finishers took home, Ethan received a week's stay at Red Wing Lodge on Sabaskong Bay, Lake of the Woods, courtesy of resort owners Mike and Annie Bartlett.

Highlights this year include:

- 60 anglers caught 72 muskies with an average length of 44.8 inches, the largest being 53.25 inches by Paul Thorne on Cass Lake.
- 7 of the top 10 finishers doubled up on muskie catches, 2nd place angler Matt McDonald tripled, and winner Ethan Stout caught four muskies.
- The surprise lake this year was Mantrap with a total of 11 muskies caught there.
- Grand Prize Drawing winners were Paul Thorne, Eric Bakke, and Christine Schmidt each received a \$4,590 check!! The social distanced drawing was held outdoors in the Northern Lights Casino parking lot.
- Lady angler Christine Schmidt placed 4th catching two muskies of 45 and 47 inches. Including the top 10 finisher prizes she won, she also won the ladies bonus along with Lauren Brion who caught a 45 inch muskie.
- Chase Whitney took home junior honors this year catching a 43 inch muskie on Leech Lake.



Ethan Stout from the Twin Cities chapter won the Frank Schneider Memorial Muskie Tournament held September 11-13, 2020 on 20+ lakes in northern Minnesota. Ethan registered 4 muskies 40-inches or longer from Mantrap Lake during the tournament, including his longest fish, this 48-incher. One of the requirements of the event was that each person's Tournament ID Badge be visible in at least one of the pictures submitted to register the fish.



Paul Thorne registered the longest fish in the Frank Schneider Memorial Muskie Tournament. This 53.25-inch muskie came from Cass Lake. Paul will receive a replica of the fish courtesy of the Twin Cities Chapter and Lax Reproductions.

52-Inch Muskie is Big Fish in George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament



Cole Klaus took first place in the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament on September 26 with this 52-inch muskie from Lake Independence.

Anglers reported seeing fish, having some near-misses, and just having a hard time getting them to eat during the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament on Saturday, September 26. In all, eleven anglers registered muskies 40 inches or over. Lake Harriett and Minnetonka produced 3 muskies each, with the rest coming from Independence, Waconia, Forest and White Bear.

Prizes were awarded to the top five anglers in the tournament. Each took home a plaque, an Eagle Tail lure (George Wahl was the creator of Eagle Tail), and a \$50 Thorne Bros. gift card.

Cole Klaus earned the most points in the tournament with a 52-inch muskie from Lake Independence. In addition to the plaque, lure and Thorne Bros. gift card, Cole received a \$1000 check for first place as well as an additional \$50 gift card from Thorne Bros. from their \$50-for-50-inch program.

Second place winner was Logan Luko who was the only angler to register more than one fish with 40.5 and 40-inch muskies from Lake Waconia. Logan reported catching 3 other muskies that were under 40 inches. Second place finish earned Logan a \$500 check.

Ryan Connelly with a 44.5-inch muskie from Lake Harriet won third place. He received a \$250 check for the third place finish.

Linda Knutson registered the only muskie caught by a lady. The 41.5-inch muskie earned her a Mary Villnow Memorial plaque and \$150 cash bonus.

Every person who registered a muskie was entered in the Grand Prize drawing. Winner of the Grand Prize, a trip for 4 to Whitefish Bay Camp on Lake of the Woods and \$500, was Mike Plog who registered his muskie only 15 minutes before fishing ended.

One hundred percent of the proceeds from this event goes towards our local metro-area muskie fishery. Thank you to all who participated in the 2020 tournament and helped contribute a little to the fishery.

Full is here, the leaves are turning, and the fish are biting. September has shown to be our best month year-to-date. We have registered 43 fish as of September 30th with most being registered in 73-78 degree water temps. We've seen water temps on registrations this month vary from a Vermilion 57 degree, to a Minnetonka 74 degree on September 1st. It appears the metro lakes are in the mid to low 60s the last week. In our Mens Masters division, we've seen Brent Hirsch jump into second place with eight fish registered as of late. Steve Agrimson registered a nice 43-inch Tiger to jump into third place in the Tiger Division. With no moves in either of the Women's standings, the most movement has happened in our Men's division.

Nathan Ryskiewicz has been on a roll and had a hot hand the past two months coming from outside the top 10 in July to 3rd place. Steve Agrimson's two September fish have taken him from 7th to 4th place, while we have Craig Johnson from Northfield entering the top 10. Outside of these shake ups, Ethan Stout, our Frank Schneider Tournament winner, has put himself in a commanding lead in the Men's division with 25 fish registered year to date. Lastly, our current September Lunker of the Month is two 49.5-inchers by Steve Agrimson and Eric Hansen.

If you're live bait fishing, make sure to keep the oxygen flowing, and let your suckers swim in big dark tanks to help them stay fresh. Looking forward to seeing some chunky fall muskies! Good luck.

Help Out with Fishing for Life's Musky Mayhem

Fishing for Life is hosting "Musky Mayhem" on Wednesday, October 28 for warriors/veterans. The goal of this event is to provide a unique, rugged, trophy-fishing experience for the participants. A sack lunch will be provided.

They are looking for volunteers to help with this event. First, they need about 20 guides to take the vets out for a day (7 am-2pm) of muskie fishing. Everyone will meet at the Long Lake Fire Department at 7 am. Once paired, guides and participants can choose the lake they want to fish.

Additionally, one or two persons to help check-in the Musky Mayhem anglers and guides before they head out for a day of chasing muskies are needed. And, lastly, they will need two or more people to make the sack lunches the night before and deliver them in the morning before participants leave for their day of fishing. Obviously, the more people who make sandwiches, the less each person will have make.

Watch for Tagged Muskies

If you're fishing Lake Minnetonka, Bald Eagle Lake or White Bear Lake, remember to be on the lookout for muskies that might have a small yellow tag near the dorsal fin. Fish with tags are part of a multi-year DNR study. If you see a yellow tag on any muskie, record the number on the tag and report the tag number, fish length and lake at http://www.dnr.state.mn.us/fisheries/tagged_fish_reporting/index.html.

Volunteer for Your Chapter

The Twin Cities chapter of Muskies, Inc. is one of the few chapters nationwide who have officer positions that are not filled. With the most members of any chapter, there should be no problem finding people to be on our board. The board meets once a month for 1-2 hours. Not much time for any one person to give.

The chapter has not had a secretary on the board for nearly a year. The chapter secretary takes minutes at the board meetings and provides copies for the next meeting. They also track who is in attendance and print out an agenda for the monthly meeting.

Elaine Randolph is our current treasurer and, for personal reasons, will not be able to continue the job next year. The treasurer reports to the board monthly on the chapter's financial status. They also responsible balancing check books and entering banking information into Quick Books. The treasurer must work with the national accountant for end-of-year reports and Quick Books files. The chapter owns the PC with Quick Books and that will be turned over to the new treasurer. Elaine will work with the new treasurer to make the transition as simple as possible.

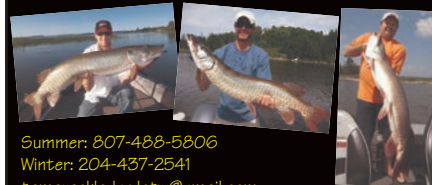
