Participate in George Wahl Tournament and Support Your Local Muskie Fishery

Our chapter's second fundraising tournament, the 13th annual George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament, will be held on September 26 from 7 am to 5 pm on 12 lakes in the metro area. One hundred percent of the proceeds from the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament will be put back into the local metro-area muskie fishery

Funds raised at the George Wahl Memorial Muskie Tournament have enabled the Twin Cities chapter to purchase and stock well over 12,500 muskie fingerlings in White Bear Lake, Bald Eagle Lake, Lake Independence, Lake Waconia, Lake Minnetonka, and

the St. Croix River over the past several years. The chapter has also been able to provide funds to the Minnesota DNR to purchase equipment for their hatcheries and by providing pit and floy tags for their studies on stocking muskies.

Bring a Kid Fishing

Entry for the George Wahl tournament is \$50. The \$100 family option for one adult and up to three juniors or two adults and up to two juniors essentially lets you bring two juniors fishing for free. With no fall sports, this is a perfect way to spend a day with your child and friends.

Minnesota High School Muskie State Championship Held August 14, 2020

The 2020 Minnesota High School Muskie State Championship day began differently than in past years due to the COVID precautions. In the morning, boats were allowed to launch from any location on the lake. Vermilion Dam Lodge (VDL) was again the headquarters for the event and central check-in location at the end of the tournament.

Nine teams (student anglers + boat captain) participated. Fishing hours were 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM and the entire lake was open for competition. This year we successfully used FishDonkey, a mobile application, to record and verify all fish catches. Tournament rules were embedded in the application and also sent to all participants prior to the tournament.

By 9:00 AM, we had two Northern Pike (29, 30 inches) and one 36.5 inch Muskie registered, all of which were caught by angler Karl Ogne. Shortly thereafter, a 49.5 inch Muskie was submitted by the team of Charlie Weiss and Erik Panyon. Charlie had landed the beauty.

We all waited in anticipation for more fish to be logged, but alas the bite had subsided for the day. Other teams saw fish but were unable to get them to commit to hooks and net. Teams gathered at Vermilion Dam Lodge after fishing for a box lunch, awards program, and pictures. All anglers took home a Plano box filled with muskie lures and Thorne Bros. gift card.

Tournament Results:

- First place – 49.5 inch Muskie – team of Charlie Weiss, Erik Panyon representing the North Metro Muskies Inc. chapter. They took home 1st place plaques, Okuma rods, and Jig Ripper handles. Charlie also won a half-day guided trip donated by Bob Benson from Northland Muskie Adventures.
- Second place – 36.5 inch Muskie – Karl Ogne representing the North Metro Muskies Inc. chapter. Karl took home 2nd place plaque, Okuma rod, and a half-day guided trip donated by Bob Benson from Northland Muskie Adventures.
- The recipient of a random draw, Christopher Baumann took home a half-day guided trip donated by Dave Schueck from Sunset Glow Guide Service

Days are shortening and the humidity seems to be falling here as we get close to September. I haven't had a chance to get on the water for Muskies yet this month but was able to sneak in two outings for bass which was a great time. I'm trusting the rest of you have been burning bucktails and getting your bodies in shape for the big baits this fall.

Our club has over doubled the amount of fish registered that we did when I wrote the last article with a total of 86 fish year to date, and 34 fish month to date. It appears the majority of fish are being registered in 73-78-degree water temps this month.

The Junior and Hybrid divisions are being dominated by Isaiah Chrissis currently who has boated 5 tiger muskies with his largest at 42.5 inches. Our July Luncker of the Month (unofficial) has had a lead change since the last issue with Eric Shultz' 50.25 inch tournament-winning fish from the St. Louis River. Ethan Stout has put himself in a distant first place in the Men's division with an impressive total of 16 muskies year to date, doubling the count of the next closest Men's angler. Nate Ryskiewicz is making a late run in the standings registering 4 fish this August and his personal best of 50 inches!

I look forward to hitting the water soon and getting back after the muskies. Enjoy your last bits of short sleeve weather, and good luck!

Watch for Tagged Muskies

Muskies stocked in Lake Minnetonka, Bald Eagle Lake and White Bear Lake for several years are part of a multi-year DNR study



on stocking. All muskies stocked in those lakes have a small yellow tag near the dorsal fin. When fishing those lakes, you should be looking for fish that have the yellow tags. By this time, the tags may be covered with algae and other material, so look closely.

If you see a yellow tag on any muskie, the DNR needs data from you to complete the study. **DO NOT REMOVE THE YELLOW TAG.** It is important that they get data on the recatchability of fish. They will need the number on the yellow tag, the name of the lake, and the length of the fish. They would also appreciate your name and phone number in case they need to follow-up. 

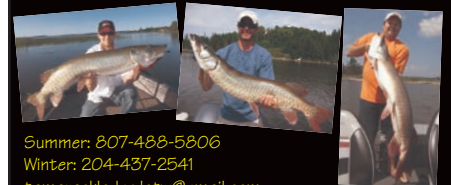
